
2. Hardware Installation

2.1. HomeArena 2.1

2.2. Front- and Back View HomeArena 2.1



1. **LINE IN** : Accepts 3.5mm stereo mini-plug input from Audio source.
2. **Left Speaker** : Chinch - RCA connector for left loudspeaker
3. **Right Speaker** : Chinch - RCA connector for right loudspeaker
4. **3D button** : Enables or disables the surround sound system
5. **LED (Green)** : Displays when speaker is receiving power.
6. **VOLUME** : Controls system volume level (Satellite and Subwoofer speakers).
7. **BASS** : Controls speaker's bass level (Subwoofer).
8. **DC IN** : Power input jack adaptor DC 12V.

2.3. Installation Instructions for HomeArena 2.1

1. Place the satellite speakers next to the monitor, one on either side. Place the subwoofer next to the speakers within reaching distance.
2. Plug the satellite speaker cables into the subwoofer's left and right speaker output jacks (2 & 3).
3. Plug the audio input cable attached to the back of the subwoofer (1) into the sound card or other audio source.
4. Before connecting the power cable, make sure the subwoofer's power switch is in the "off" or "out" position. Plug the power adapter cable into the subwoofer's power input jack (8). Plug the power adapter into a standard household electrical outlet.
5. Press the subwoofer's power knob (4) to turn on the system. The green LED Light should illuminate.
6. Activate the audio the audio source to test speakers.

3. Operating Instructions for HomeArena 2.1

1. Avoid exposing speakers to environments that are excessively warm and humid (particularly in unventilated spaces or nearby heaters) or dusty.
2. Do not set speakers near windows exposed to direct sunlight or in areas near to water
3. Clean speaker housing by wiping with mild cleaning solution. Do not use solvents!
4. The loudspeakers are magnetically shielded and you can place them also in the near of your PC monitor.
5. "!" Warning : Before connecting or disconnecting the loudspeakers from the main electricity make sure that the speaker's control button is in the " OFF " position.
